


Removal

1. Remove three screws and lower door trim panel.


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
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
- 4. Remove one screw at inner door latch release lever.
- 5. Remove two screws from the front and two screws from the rear of upper door trim panel.
- 6. Remove three screws at lower edge of trim panel.
- 7. Remove mirror trim cover.

- 8. Disconnect wiring harness at power window switch. Remove window switch assembly from door panel.
- 9. Remove speaker and disconnect connector. Refer to Section 35-30.
- 10. Remove handle reinforcement bracket from door if necessary.






- 2. Connect and install speaker.

- 4. Install window switch assembly to door trim panel, if removed.




- 5. Make sure wiring and linkage rods are in proper positions.

8. Install pull handle with two screws. Install handle cover.





Watershield

Removal and Installation


- 1. Remove door trim panel as outlined.
- 2. Peel back watershield as far back as necessary.
- 3. Reposition watershield. Weatherstrip Adhesive COAZ-19552-AA or equivalent should be used to reseal watershield if existing adhesive will no longer seal watershield.
- 4. Patches are serviced in the same manner as watershield.



Trim Panel, Cowl Side

Removal

- 1. Pull back door opening weatherstrip.
- 2. Remove push pin and screw retaining trim panel.
- 3. Remove panel.







Trim Panels, Rear Quarter Removal

- 1. Remove door scuff plate. Refer to Section 45-16.
- 2. Remove rear seat back and cushion. Refer to Section 41-20.
- 3. Remove bolt retaining outer rear safety belts. Refer to Section 41-50.
- 4. Remove two plugs, two screws, and quarter trim panel covers.






5. If necessary, remove cover plate from driver's side quarter trim panel.




- 6. Pull door opening weatherstrip away from quarter trim panel.
- 7. Remove screw from top of quarter trim panel.
- 8. Remove two plastic rivets from rear edge of quarter trim panel.
- 9. Carefully pry out clip located in the upper rear corner of trim panel as shown.
- 10. Disconnect speaker and remove trim panel.
- 11. Remove speaker. Refer to Section 35-30.



Installation

- 1. Install speaker if removed.
- 2. Place clip in holder on rear of quarter trim panel.
- 3. Connect speaker and position quarter trim panel into place. Press at clip location to secure clip.
- 4. Install plastic rivets at rear edge of trim panel.
- 5. Install screw on top of quarter trim panel.
- 6. Fit door opening weatherstrip onto flange and trim panel. Make sure to engage retainers.



REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

Convertible Top Retainer

Removal

- 1. Raise convertible top enough to gain access to retainer.
- 2. Remove two screws and retainer.




Installation

- 1. Install retainer and two retaining screws. Tighten screws to 7-10 N·m (5-7 lb-ft).
- 2. Check convertible top for proper operation and fit.

Windshield Moulding, Side

Removal

- 1. Remove convertible top retainer as outlined.
- 2. Remove sun visor and center support.
- 3. Peel back weatherstrip as required.
- 4. Pull upper windshield moulding away.
- 5. Slide off moulding at two clip locations as shown.
- 6. Remove side moulding from vehicle.




Installation

- 1. Insert lower retainer if removed.
- 2. Snap clips into moulding, if removed.
- 3. Position moulding and slide onto retaining clips.
- 4. Position upper windshield moulding and weatherstrip.
- 5. Install sun visor and center support.
- 6. Install convertible top retainer as outlined.

Windshield Moulding, Upper

Removal

- 1. Remove convertible top retainer and side moulding as outlined.
- 2. Remove two screws and sun visor from each side.
- 3. Remove screw and sun visor center support.
- 4. Peel back weatherstrip as required and remove upper windshield moulding.




Installation

- 1. Position upper windshield moulding.

Hardtop Header Trim Cover

Removal

- 1. Remove upper windshield moulding as outlined.
- 2. Remove hardtop retaining bolt.
- 3. Remove two retaining screws and header trim cover.



- 1. Install header trim cover with two retaining screws. Tighten to 4.4-5 N·m (36-39 lb-in).
- 2. Install hardtop retaining bolt.



Door Scuff Plate and Side Trim Removal

- 1. Remove door scuff plate retaining screws.
- 2. Remove scuff plate by sliding it forward.

Installation

- 2. Fit door scuff plate to side trim panel and position properly on door opening.
- 3. Install door scuff plate retaining screws.
- 4. Tighten all screws securely.


The floor console on this vehicle is divided into two sections; the front console and the rear console. The front section contains an ash receptacle, cigarette lighter and gear shift selector. The rear section contains a storage tray, coin holder, parking brake lever, switch controls for power side view mirrors and a map/beverage holder.

REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

Console, Rear


Removal

- 1. Slide the front seats completely forward.
- 2. Remove the screws retaining the rear of the console.
- 3. Slide the front seat completely rearward.
- 4. Remove the screws retaining the rear console to the front console.
- 5. Raise parking lever as far as it will go.
- 6. Raise the rear of the console and pull backwards to remove.




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
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- 7. If equipped with a manual transaxle, remove screws and front console leaving shift knob and boot on shift lever.
- 8. Unscrew shift knob with boot and remove from shift lever if necessary.




9. On vehicles equipped with an automatic transaxle, remove screws and shift quadrant. Disconnect shift quadrant lamp connector.



Installation


- 1. If equipped with an automatic transaxle, install the shift guadrant.
- 2. If equipped with a manual transaxle, install the shift knob and boot.
- 3. If equipped with a manual transaxle, position boot into console and install retaining screws.
- 4. Position front console covers and install retaining screws.
- 5. Position ash receptacle and connect wiring beneath it.
- 6. If equipped with an automatic transaxle, install shift handle. Tighten jam nut to 15-20 N-m (11-15 lb-ft).
- 7. Install rear console as outlined.



Shifter Boot

Removal

1. Remove front console as outlined.



Installation

- 1. Install shifter boot and shifter knob in front console and secure with four screws.
- 2. Install front console as outlined.


The instrument panel houses all of the heater / air conditioning controls as well as the radio, clock, rear window defogger switch, fog lamp switch and instrument panel dimmer switch.

REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

Instrument Cluster Bezel

Removal

- 1. Pull out storage compartment. Remove two upper screws, two lower screws, and heater/radio bezel.
- 2. Remove trim covers located on both sides of steering column by pulling outward.
- Remove retaining screws and carefully pull instrument cluster bezel partially away from instrument panel.
- 4. Disconnect electrical connectors from clock and switches in bezel.




Installation

- 1. Connect electrical connectors to clock and switches.
- 2. Position instrument cluster bezel and install retaining screws.
- 3. Position trim covers on both sides of steering column and snap into place.
- 4. Position heater/radio bezel and install securing screws.
- 5. Install storage compartment if equipped.


Instrument Panel Assembly Removal

- 1. Disconnect negative battery cable.
- 2. Remove LH and RH lower cowl trim panels. Refer to Section 45-03.
- 3. Remove front and rear floor consoles. Refer to Section 45-31.
- 4. Remove heater / radio bezel, trim covers, instrument cluster bezel, and storage compartment as outlined.




- 5. Remove instrument cluster. Refer to Section 33-01.
- 6. Remove steering column. Refer to Section 13-04.
- 7. Loosen nut retaining hood release cable to lower instrument panel and position cable aside.
- 8. Remove radio. Refer to Section 35-01.
- 9. Remove heater control panel. Refer to Section 36-01.
- 10. Tag and remove all wiring harness retainers and connectors from instrument panel.

- 11. Remove three screws, lockwashers, and plain washers located near base of windshield.
- 12. Remove two bolts and washers from each side of instrument panel. An access panel is provided for upper bolts.
- 13. Remove two screws and lockwashers retaining instrument panel to center floor bracket.
- 14. Remove two screws retaining instrument panel to steering column support.
- With an assistant, gently slide instrument panel outward. Disconnect ducts and wiring during removal.




- 16. Remove lamp, screws and upper glove compartment support bracket from instrument panel assembly.
- 17. Remove screws and radio support bracket.
- 18. Remove defroster grilles from instrument panel pad.
- 19. Remove two screws above instrument cluster, three screws above glove compartment, and two screws from underside of instrument panel. Remove instrument panel pad.
- 20. Remove passenger side register from pad.




Installation

- 1. Install passenger side register into instrument panel pad.
- 2. Install instrument panel pad with screws and tighten securely.
- 3. Install defroster grilles.
- 4. Install radio support bracket into instrument panel.
- 5. Install glove compartment support with screws. Install lamp.



- 6. With an assistant, position instrument panel on its support braces. Connect ducts and route wiring harness as needed.
- 7. Install two screws retaining instrument panel to steering column support.
- 8. Install two lockwashers and screws into center bracket. Tighten to 4-5 N.m (36-44 lb-in).
- 9. Install four washers and bolts into sides of instrument panel. Tighten to 7-10 N-m(62-88 lb-in).
- 10. Install access covers on both sides of instrument panel.
- 11. Install three screws on instrument panel near windshield. Tighten securely.



- 12. Fasten wiring harness to instrument panel.
- 13. Install heater control panel and connect cables. Refer to Section 36-10.
- 14. Install radio. Refer to Section 35-01.

- 15. Position hood release cable and tighten retaining nut.
- 16. Install steering column. Refer to Section 13-04.
- 17. Install instrument cluster. Refer to Section 33-01.

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
